

LSM50 - Silicone Rubber Sheet

DESCRIPTION

LSM50 is a 51 durometer, high strength silicone rubber that could be used as a re-usable vacuum membrane. It can be used also to make inflatable bladders used in composite parts manufacturing like tubes, hallow parts. LSM50 exists in both uncured and cured stage in various thicknesses from 0.9mm to 3.5mm.

◆ RECOMMENDED CURING CONDITIONS

LSM50 cures from 120°c under pressure. The higher the pressure will be the better wil be the results and details on the cured membrane..

◆ STORAGE

For uncured rubber: 6 months from date of manufacture when stored at 24°c and wrapped as supplied. For cured rubber: no limitation if stored at 24°c max in a dry and clean area.

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
